

PRIVACY POLICY

1. COOKIES

By accepting this Privacy Policy, the user consents to store cookies on his/her device. A cookie is a file of information sent by a website and kept by the browser, and is used to store and retrieve anonymous information regarding navigation on the device.

The categories of cookies used on this website, and the purpose thereof, are the following:

PHPSESSID – php default cookie used to store private key to encrypt session data. Only one user with the correct key can decrypt session data. You can learn how to configure the installation or uninstall cookies through the help section of your browser.

2. DATA PROTECTION

To monitor the use of our website, our hosting servers collect and store during six months the meta-data of all users' visits, including the IP of their devices. While the IP does not allow us to identify a particular user, an Internet provider can, thus we will treat this information as personal data and protect it with the utmost confidentiality.

We will not transfer this information to third parties, unless strictly necessary to comply with orders from competent authorities or valid legislation.
